Salient points of speech of Hon'ble Union Home Minister & Minister of Cooperation and Senior BJP Leader Shri Amit Shah while addressing party karyakartas of Saharsa, Purnia and Bhagalpur divisions in Forbesganj (Araria, Bihar)

Rahul Baba and Lalu Ji are in the field to make their party and sons win, but the BJP is in the field to drive out infiltrators from Bihar

Elect the NDA with a two-thirds majority, I promise you that we will drive out infiltrators from the soil of Bihar one by one

This election in Bihar is to put the state on the path of progress, make it infiltrator-free, and prevent the return of jungle raj

No one's vote was cut among the people of Kosi and Seemanchal, because only those who have come by infiltrating had their votes cut

Rahul Baba, no matter how many yatras you undertake, the BJP is determined that we will remove every infiltrator one by one

One is Sonia ji's Lal , the other Lalu ji's Lal; these two Shehzade should tell what they have done for Bihar?

Hon'ble Union Home Minister and Minister of Cooperation and senior Bharatiya Janata Party leader Shri Amit Shah today addressed a party karyakartas from 10 districts Purnia, Katihar, Kishanganj, Araria, Supaul, Saharsa, Madhepura, Bhagalpur, Banka and Naugachhia of 'Saharsa, Purnia and Bhagalpur' division in Araria (Bihar) and called upon to work hard and form the NDA government once again in Bihar. He expressed confidence that the people of Bihar will help the NDA win more than 160 seats and form the government in the state. State BJP President Shri Dilip Jaiswal, Bihar Deputy Chief Ministers Shri Samrat Chaudhary and Shri Vijay Sinha, Union Minister Shri Nityanand Rai, Araria Lok Sabha MP Shri Pradeep Singh and other senior party leaders were present at the event.

Shri Shah said that the BJP is different from other parties because, in the BJP, the credit for electoral victory goes not to the leaders but to the dedicated karyakartas. He accused Rahul Gandhi and Lalu Yadav of wanting to give voting rights to infiltrators and said that BJP karyakartas will prevent this. He mentioned various development projects of the Modi government, including financial assistance to farmers, pensions for women and the elderly, flood control measures, and airport construction. Shri Shah stated that this election is about taking Bihar on the path of progress and strengthening the NDA government.

The Hon'ble Union Home Minister said that when the election draws closer, all political parties hold public rallies, but the Bharatiya Janata Party is unique in that it first organizes a Karyakarta Sammelan. Other parties win elections based on leaders, but the BJP's electoral strength lies not in leaders but in its karyakartas. Today, over 4,000 selected karyakartas from Bhagalpur, Kosi, and Seemanchal regions are present here. In the 2020 Assembly elections, except for Kishanganj, the NDA alliance was number one in every district. NDA was also number one in Naugachhia, Bhagalpur, Banka, Araria, Purnia, Katihar, Supaul, Saharsa, and Madhepura. The shortfall in Kishanganj will now be fully covered by the BJP karyakartas this time.

Shri Shah said that for Rahul Gandhi and Lalu Prasad Yadav, this election is about winning for their parties. For Lalu Prasad Yadav, it is about making his son the Chief Minister. But for BJP karyakartas, this election is about driving out infiltrators from across Bihar. Once the people of Bihar give NDA a two-thirds majority, infiltrators will be removed one by one from the sacred land of Bihar. For the BJP, this election is also about permanently freeing the Kosi region from floods. The people of Bihar will celebrate four Diwalis this time: the first marking Bhagwan Shri Ram's return to Ayodhya; the second for the historic occasion when Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi ji transferred ₹10,000 into the bank accounts of Jeevika Didis; the third celebrating the reduction of prices of over 395 items by 15–20% through GST reforms; and the fourth when the people of Bihar give more than 160 seats to NDA, forming the government.

The Hon'ble Union Home Minister said that just as ₹10,000 reached Jeevika Didis, Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi ji has been transferring ₹6,000 annually to farmers' accounts, and with this year's bumper crop, farmers' incomes will rise. This Diwali, everyone should resolve to buy only Swadeshi products. In Bihar, Lalu and his associates looted the state through various scams, while Congress siphoned off ₹12 lakh crore of national resources. Over the past 11 years, Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi ji's government has worked with such transparency that no one has been able to accuse it of even a single instance of corruption.

Shri Shah said that some time ago Rahul Gandhi visited Bihar and even led a march; he did so because the Election Commission is removing infiltrators from Bihar's voter lists. Lalu Yadav and Rahul Gandhi want infiltrators to be given voting rights in Bihar. Let Rahul Gandhi hear this clearly: he may hold marches anywhere, but the BJP's resolve is to identify and remove every single infiltrator one by one. Lalu Yadav and Rahul Gandhi's parties want to protect infiltrators, whereas the Bharatiya Janata Party wants them removed.

The Hon'ble Union Home Minister said that Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi ji has undertaken numerous initiatives for Bihar's development. From Purnia, PM Modi announced the Makhana Board. In Bhagalpur, a 2,400 MW coal power plant was established. PM Modi fulfilled his promise of giving Purnia an airport, and now Patna, Gaya, Darbhanga, and Purnia airports are operational, with Bihta Airport to start soon bringing Bihar's total to six airports. Earlier, floods occurred in the Kosi due to Nepal's rivers, but now PM Modi announced the Kosi Link Project in the 2025 budget to provide irrigation instead of causing floods. While Lalu Prasad Yadav and the INDI Alliance did nothing for Bihar, PM Modi's government provided 1.17 crore women with gas cylinders, 1.5 crore people with toilets, 48 lakh mothers under the Matru Vandana Yojana, and yesterday ₹10,000 was transferred to 75,000 Jeevika Didi accounts. The Bihar NDA government increased old age, widow, and disability pensions from ₹400 to ₹1,100.

Shri Shah said that at Sitamarhi's Punaura Dham, a grand Sita Mata temple is being constructed with a joint effort of Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi ji and Bihar CM Shri Nitish Kumar at a cost of ₹900 crore. Rahul Gandhi had mocked BJP, saying, "The temple will be built, but the date won't be announced." While Congress leaders taunted the construction of the Ram Mandir in Ayodhya, the people of India and Bihar re-elected PM Modi, who performed the Bhoomi Pujan in 2019 and the Prana Pratishtha, completing the Bhavya Ram Mandir where Ram Lalla had remained in a tent for 550 years. The NDA government announced internships of ₹4,000 for 12th pass students, ₹5,000 for diploma holders, and ₹6,000 for graduates. Free electricity up to 125 units has been provided to about 1.67 crore people. ASHA workers' honorarium was increased from ₹1,000 to ₹3,000, and Mamta workers' from ₹300 to ₹600.

Union Home Minister Shri Amit Shah said that Sonia Gandhi's scions and Lalu Prasad Yadav's scions should answer what they have done for Bihar. When the Sonia-Manmohan-Lalu government was at the Centre, Bihar received only ₹2.8 lakh crore in 10 years. From 2014 to 2025, Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi ji has provided nearly ₹16 lakh crore to Bihar, including road and irrigation projects, revival of Barauni factories, restarting sugar mills, the Kosi Link Project, and several power plants. PM Modi abolished Article 370, ended triple talaq, granted citizenship to Hindu refugees via CAA, and eliminated terrorists in Pakistan through Operation Sindoor after the Pulwama attack. Under Hon'ble PM Shri Narendra Modi Ji, the country prospered, the economy rose from 11th to 4th rank, and national security improved. During Lalu Yadav's tenure as Bihar CM, per capita income was only ₹8,000; today it has increased to ₹68,000, raising Bihar's prosperity by ₹60,000 per person.

Shri said that Sonia Gandhi's Lal and Lalu Prasad Yadav's Lal, both these princes should answer what they have done for Bihar. When the government of Sonia-Manmohan and Lalu Prasad Yadav was at the Centre, only ₹2,80,000 crore was given to Bihar in 10 years. From 2014 to 2025, the Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi Ji has worked to provide Bihar with nearly ₹16 lakh crore, including road and irrigation projects, revival of factories in Barauni, restarting sugar mills, the Kosi Link Project, and several power plants. Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi Ji abrogated Article 370, ended Triple Talaq, gave citizenship to Hindu refugees through the CAA, and when Pakistani terrorists carried out an attack in Pahalgam, through Operation Sindur, terrorists were eliminated by entering Pakistan's home. The Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra

Modi ji has enriched the country, raised the country's economy from eleventh place to fourth place, and made the country secure. When Lalu Yadav was the Chief Minister of Bihar, the per capita income in Bihar was only ₹8,000. Today it has reached ₹68,000, that is, an increase of ₹60,000 in per capita income. Along with this growth, the work of making Bihar prosperous has also been carried out.

The Hon'ble Union Home Minister, addressing the karyakartas, said that this election is an election to take Bihar on the path of progress. This is an election to remove infiltrators from Bihar. This election is so that Lalu Prasad Yadav's Jungle Raj does not come again. This election is to strengthen the country and the Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi Ji. In Seemanchal, NDA is winning several seats, but this does not make the figure 160. BJP and NDA will have to increase their seats in every district. We will cross the figure of 160, form the NDA government again, and strengthen the Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi Ji.
