## Salient Points of speech of Hon'ble Union Home Minister & Minister of Cooperation Shri Amit Shah while addressing at the Concluding Ceremony of the *Tamilagam Thalai Nimira Tamilanin Payanam Yatra* in Pudukkottai, Tamil Nadu

The 'Tamilagam Thalai Nimira Tamilanin Payanam' yatra has laid a strong foundation for change in Tamil Nadu, and the formation of an NDA government here is certain.

In 2026, BJP–NDA governments are set to be formed with an overwhelming majority in both Bengal and Tamil Nadu.

The time has come to end the rule of one family in Tamil Nadu.

\*\*\*\*\*

Since Independence, Prime Minister Modi has done more work for the great Tamil language than anyone else.

The DMK government has committed atrocities against Hindus and violated the constitutional limits and values.

\*\*\*\*\*

The DMK government of Tamil Nadu has broken all records of betrayal and is the most corrupt government in the country.

The DMK government's objective is to make Stalin's son, Udhayanidhi, the Chief Minister, but the NDA will not allow this to happen.

Tamil Nadu can be freed from the DMK's corruption, dynastic politics, and misgovernance only through a BJP–AIADMK natural alliance government.

A DMK government involved in cash-for-jobs scams, money laundering, illegal sand mining, and call scams can never work for the welfare of Tamil Nadu.

In Tamil Nadu, there is a government that takes a 20% commission in every scheme.

Under the Tamil Nadu government, farmers, teachers, nurses, anganwadi workers, and sanitation workers are being forced to protest, and in return, they are receiving only lathi charges and imprisonment

Hon'ble Union Home Minister and Minister of Cooperation Shri Amit Shah addressed the *Karyakartas* at the concluding ceremony of the “*Tamilagam Thalai Nimira Tamilanin Payanam Yatra*” in Pudukkottai, Tamil Nadu on Sunday and stated that the ***Tamilagam Thalai Nimira Tamilanin Payanam Yatra, which has been conducted across Tamil Nadu since 12 October, has now become a strong foundation for change in the state, and the formation of an NDA government in April 2026 is certain. Tamil Nadu, which is struggling with corruption, dynastic politics and misgovernance, now needs a decisive change, and this change is possible only through the natural alliance of the Bharatiya Janata Party and the AIADMK.*** During the event, Tamil Nadu BJP State President Shri Nainar Nagendran, Union Ministers Shri Piyush Goyal, Shri L. Murugan, Shri Arjun Ram Meghwal, former State President Shri K. Annamalai, Shri N. Ramachandran and other leaders were present.

Shri Shah highlighted that today is the concluding ceremony of the *Tamilagam Thalai Nimira Tamilanin Payanam Yatra* led by BJP State President Shri Nainar Nagendran. At this ceremony, he assured all the *Karyakartas* present that an **NDA government is going to be formed in Tamil Nadu in April 2026**. Addressing a massive gathering, Shri Shah called upon the people of Tamil Nadu to connect the state with India's journey of development under the leadership of the Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi Ji. This Yatra has carried out public outreach programmes across almost the entire Tamil Nadu from 12 October till today. In the upcoming Assembly elections, the Bharatiya Janata Party, along with the AIADMK and other allies, is going to form a strong alliance to give a final fight to the Congress and the DMK.

Hon'ble Union Home Minister stated that the **DMK government has failed on every front and that the most corrupt government in the entire country is the Tamil Nadu government. If there is any government that has fulfilled the fewest promises made in its manifesto, it is the DMK government of Tamil Nadu. There is no guarantee of the safety of mothers and sisters in Tamil Nadu, and the sole objective of the DMK government is to make Stalin's son, Udhayanidhi Stalin, the Chief Minister.** But now the time has come to put an end to dynastic politics in Tamil Nadu. **First Karunanidhi, then Stalin, and now Udhayanidhi Stalin this dream of the DMK is not going to be fulfilled. In April 2026, an NDA government is going to be formed in Tamil Nadu. The alliance between the Bharatiya Janata Party and the AIADMK is a natural alliance. In 1998, both parties contested elections together; the 2019 Lok Sabha elections were also contested together, and the 2021 Assembly elections were likewise fought jointly. Although the 2024 Lok Sabha elections were contested separately, when the votes of the Bharatiya Janata Party and the AIADMK were added together, the NDA emerged victorious in 36 seats.**

Shri Shah pointed out that **Chief Minister Stalin has started propaganda claiming that the NDA is opposed to the Tamil language, whereas the truth is exactly the opposite. The initiative to conduct IAS and IPS examinations in the Tamil language was first started by the Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi Ji. The work of making announcements in Tamil at railway stations in Tamil Nadu was also undertaken by the Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi Ji. The establishment of the Subramania Bharati Chair at Banaras Hindu University for the study of Tamil, and the translation of the great text Thirukkural into thirteen Indian languages, were also carried out under the leadership of the Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi Ji. The BJP government initiated the conduct of medical and engineering examinations in the Tamil language. The Government of India started teaching programmes in the Tamil language in Fiji, and the great Sengol was kept in a museum for years by the Congress and the DMK was installed in Parliament. Recently, the election of Shri Radhakrishnan ji to the post of Vice President of India was also accomplished under the leadership of the Bharatiya Janata Party and the Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi Ji.**

Senior BJP leader noted that **today the DMK government has become synonymous with corruption. Even after one of its ministers went to jail, he continued to remain a minister for 243**

days. One leader's name has surfaced in the "cash for job" scam, another leader's name has come up in a money laundering case, one leader is involved in a sand mining scam, and another leader is accused in a coal scam. A DMK leader has been implicated in a ₹6,000 crore CRIDP scam. With such an army of corrupt ministers, the DMK cannot develop Tamil Nadu. Every scheme in Tamil Nadu carries a 20 percent corruption cut money burden, and the entire budget of Tamil Nadu runs only on debt and black money from liquor. When sanitation workers protest, they are *Lathi-Charged*. When nurses, community health officers and *Anganwadi* workers protest, 600 nurses are sent to jail. The Tamil Nadu government has also cheated farmers. Hindu faith and beliefs are being continuously attacked in Tamil Nadu. During the Ayodhya Ram Mandir Puja in Tamil Nadu, an undeclared curfew is imposed, and senior leaders call *Sanatan Dharma* dengue and malaria. The DMK government has also imposed a stay on the immersion of Hindu idols. Chief Minister Stalin has committed atrocities against Hindu society and has worked to violate the constitutional limits of the country.

Shri Amit Shah remarked that the Modi government has given Tamil Nadu many major infrastructure projects. From 2024 onwards, under the leadership of the Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi ji, a massive victory journey of the NDA has been underway. In 2024, the Hon'ble Shri Narendra Modi ji became the Prime Minister of the country for the third time. In 2024, for the first time, a BJP government was formed in Odisha and an NDA government was formed in Andhra Pradesh. In 2025, a BJP government was formed in Haryana for the third consecutive time and a BJP-NDA government was formed for the third time in Maharashtra. In 2025, after 27 years, a Bharatiya Janata Party government was formed in Delhi. In 2025, the Bharatiya Janata Party completely wiped out the INDI alliance in Bihar. Now it is the turn of Tamil Nadu and Bengal. Today, from this conference, all *Karyakartas* must leave with the resolve that 2024–25 have been years of victory for the Bharatiya Janata Party, and now in 2026, governments of the NDA and the Bharatiya Janata Party must be formed with an overwhelming majority in Tamil Nadu and West Bengal.
